At Cityscape, he leads an overall operation of the production homebuilding and development platform, as well as the network of master builders, architects, urban planners, engineers and sales/marketing firms, all working together with a single goal in mind—to create desirable intown communities that lift existing neighborhoods up.

Since founding the JLW Community Foundation in 2003, Robb has been an active volunteer with the Morehouse Mentoring Program, Covenant House, and Hands on Atlanta.
